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
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
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


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


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Left Image: Akron within Summit County.


LOCATION DESCRIPTION

The Akron, OH Metropolitan Statistical Area, sometimes referred to as Greater Akron, is defined by the United States Office of Management and Budget as an area consisting of two counties, Summit and Portage, in Northeast Ohio and anchored by the city of Akron. As of the 2020 census, the MSA had a population of 702,219. The Akron MSA is also part of the larger Cleveland–Akron–Canton, OH Combined Statistical Area, which has a population of 3,633,962 people as of the 2020 census, the largest metropolitan area in Ohio.

Akron is the 5th largest city in the state of Ohio. A long history of rubber and tire manufacturing, carried on today by The Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company, gave Akron the nickname "Rubber Capital of the World". Akron has won economic awards such as for City Livability and All-American City, and deemed a high tech haven greatly contributing to the Information Age. Ohio's Polymer Valley is centered in Akron. The area holds forty-five percent of the state's polymer industries, with the oldest dating to the 19th century, and is now internationally recognized as the "Polymer Center of the Americas." Today, its economy includes manufacturing, education, healthcare, and biomedical research; leading corporations include: Gojo Industries, FirstEnergy, Huntington Bank, and Charter Spectrum.



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


DEMOGRAPHICS: 5 MILE RADIUS 2981 S ARLINGTON RE

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
DEMOGRAPHICS: 10 MILE RADIUS

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2981 S Arlington Rd, Akron, Ohio, 44312 Ring of 10 miles



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


DEMOGRAPHICS: 15 MILE RADIUS
